For a year from Sep 1st 2023, Rev. Satya Robyn will say a daily prayer for the Earth in a public place.

Why?

It is now impossible to deny the harm humankind has inflicted upon our Earth. Prayer inoculates us against the despair that leads to inaction, connects us back into the Earth's beauty, and gives us the courage to take small compassionate actions and to face whatever is coming.

What and where?

Satya will both read a prayer online every day at 8am UK time, and read a prayer out loud at the top of Great Malvern at 8.30am every day. After each prayer there will be ten minutes of silence for people who wish to stay and contemplate or pray in their own way.
